



## **LEGALLY BRIEF:**

### **2020 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION INFORMATION**

Due to the coronavirus pandemic, all dates associated with the 2020 Indiana Primary Election have been delayed by 28 days by order of the Indiana Election Commission.

The new date is set for **TUESDAY, JUNE 2, 2020** and applies to all Indiana counties and election boards.

Voting is expected to take place throughout the state from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. local time.

Deadline for Voter Registration is Monday, May 4, 2020. You can register to vote online by visiting <https://indianavoters.in.gov/>.

### **ABSENTEE VOTING**

All registered and qualified Indiana voters are able to vote no-excuse absentee by mail. To request an absentee-by-mail ballot, you will need to complete form *ABS-Mail Primary 2020* and return it to your county election officials by **May 21, 2020, 11:59 p.m. local time.**
