### COVID-19 & TAXES: HIGHLIGHTS

- ALL **2019 tax year** deadlines are extended in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Indiana residents will have until **July 15, 2020**, to file their individual tax returns and make any estimated payments; this was extended from **April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020**.
- Likewise, all FEDERAL tax filing deadlines have been moved from **April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to July 15, 2020**.
- The IRS also says that people who have filed or plan to can still expect to receive a refund if they are owed one.
- It may be important for you to file a tax return even if you have not in the past, because any cash payments made to individuals pursuant to the new federal CARES ACT will be deposited into the account that is linked to your tax filings.
